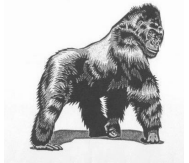

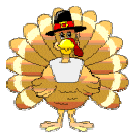
Our Fall Festival will be held Nov. 7 from 12-2. We will have bouncy things, indoor festival games, hot dogs, and a cake walk.

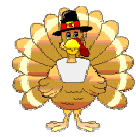
